

# Tour of Southland Kids Jersey Design Competition

## Terms and Conditions.

1. The Promoter of the Competition, Southland Building Society is a registered bank and operates under the brand "SBS Bank".
2. SBS Bank will select a winning jersey design from all entries. The winning design will appear on an official cycling jersey worn by a rider in the SBS Bank 2019 Tour of Southland and the competition winner will also receive a \$500 Rebel Sports Voucher (the "**Prize**").
3. The competition will run from Wednesday 4 September 2019 to Saturday 21 September 2019.
4. To enter this competition:
  - a. entrants must:
    - (a) be resident in New Zealand
    - (b) be aged 12 years or under; and
    - (c) have consent of their parent or guardian.
  - b. entrants need to submit a jersey design which:
    - (a) they have created themselves; and
    - (b) does not contain copyrighted material of third parties;
  - c. each jersey design must be accompanied by a completed entry form signed by the entrant's parent or guardian; and
  - d. entrants must submit the jersey design and entry form before 4.30pm on Saturday 21 September 2019 either:
    - (a) in person at their nearest SBS Branch;

    - (c) by post to: Kids Jersey Competition, PO Box 835, Invercargill 9840.
5. SBS Bank reserves the right to determine, in its sole discretion, whether a prize winner has met the qualifying criteria outlined in paragraphs 4 and 5 above.
6. Only one prize of a \$500 Rebel Sports Voucher is available to be won as part of this competition. The competition winner will be selected by a panel of SBS Bank staff.
