

## Dear Member

As one of our Members who uses an SBS Bank EFTPOS Card (your gold or white SBS Card), we would like to make you aware of an important change to your card.

On 12 April 2019, your EFTPOS card will no longer be able to be used overseas as the functionality that allows this will be switched off. This affects use of Mastercard's Maestro and Cirrus payment networks, which are the logos that currently appear on the back of your card.

**You can still use your card for EFTPOS and ATM transactions in New Zealand.**

This also means that our Eftpos Card Terms and Conditions will be updated to reflect this change. These Terms and Conditions are available free of charge on request, in any branch or can be viewed on our website at [sbsbank.co.nz/terms-conditions](https://www.sbsbank.co.nz/terms-conditions).

### What Do You Need to Do?

If you don't use your card overseas, or don't intend to in future, you do not need to do anything. The ability to use your card overseas will simply be turned off on Friday 12 April.
