



Once you've started to find properties that you're interested in it's time to start house viewing! But how do you know if you've found a gem? It's important to have a think about what you want, what you need, and what you are willing to compromise on before you start hunting for your home.

Check out our checklist below as a starting point of what to look for when house hunting – and add in your own selling points! You might also consider taking along friends or family members that have previously bought a home, as they'll be able to offer extra support and advice.

General things to look for:
Does the house look well-built, and in good condition? What do the neighbouring properties look like? Is there are driveway or garage for parking? Is there easy access from the road to the house? Does the house get natural light from the sun, or is it blocked? Are there any shared spaces like courtyards or driveways? Is the house insulated? Are the floors level? Is the water pressure good? Is there enough space for you and your possessions? Does the wiring work look safe? Is the house warm, or does it feel damp? Is the property safe and secure?
