

Southland Sharks Ball Carrier Prize Draw Terms and Conditions

- 2. SBS Bank is offering the chance to win one (1) ball carrier prize (the "Prize")
- 3. Each Prize is for a winning entrant (the "Winner") to:
 - a. be an official ball carrier at The Southland Sharks home game on June 21, 2024 in the 2024 National Basketball League;
 - b. receive two General Admission tickets (for the Winner and one Parent/Grandparent or Legal Guardian) to attend the game that the Winner will be the official ball carrier;
 - c. receive an official ball carrier top to be worn at the game that the Winner will be the official ball carrier (and to keep!); and
