



SBS Bank Southland Sharks Ball Carrier Prize Draw Terms and Conditions

- 1) The promoter of the SBS Bank Southland Sharks Ball Carrier Prize Draw (the “**Competition**”), Southland Building Society, is a registered bank and operates under the brand “**SBS Bank**”. The Competition is not sponsored, endorsed, administered by, or associated with Meta Platforms, Inc. You completely release Meta Platforms, Inc from any and all liability associated with the Competition.
- 2) SBS Bank is offering the chance to win one (1) ball carrier prize (the “Prize”) at selected games.
- 3) Each Prize is for the winning entrant’s nominated child (the “Winner”) to:
 - a) be an official ball carrier at selected SBS Bank Southland Sharks home games in the 2026 National Basketball League;
 - b) receive two General Admission tickets (for the Winner and one Parent/Grandparent or Legal Guardian) to attend the game that the Winner will be the official ball carrier;
 - c) receive an official ball carrier top to be worn at the game that the Winner will be the official ball carrier (and to keep!);
- 4) The Competition will run from Tuesday 21 April 2026 at 5pm to 9am on Thursday 23 April 2026.
- 5) To enter the Competition:
 - a) entrants nominated child need to be aged between 8 and 12 (evidence of age may be required);
 - b) entrants need to be New Zealand residents
- 6) Entries must be submitted by typing **ball carrier** in the comments section of the respective Facebook post by the parent or legal guardian of the Winner.
- 7) SBS Bank reserves the right to determine, in its sole discretion, whether a prize winner has met the qualifying criteria outlined in paragraph 5 above.
- 8) Only one entry in the Competition per person is allowed.
- 9) The Winners will be drawn during the 2026 National Basketball League. The parent or legal guardians of the Winners will be contacted to confirm the details and the prize winners will be announced on the SBS Bank Facebook page.
- 10) Where a Winner is drawn but the parent or legal guardian of that person:
 - a) does not respond to SBS Bank within five working days;
 - b) is unable to produce evidence of their qualifying criteria;
 - c) is ineligible to enter the Competition by virtue of clause 5; or
 - d) is unable to attend the Southland Sharks Invercargill home game nominated by SBS Bank as part of the prize with the prize Winner.
